

1. Promoter

This competition is conducted by Acacia Ridge Hotel in conjunction with the 2026 Season of NRL Telstra Premiership Rugby League.

2. Competition Type

This is a game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining overall season winner. Weekly prizes may involve random prize allocation but are awarded based on skill-based results.

3. Eligibility

- Entry is open to persons ages 18 years and over
- Proof of age must be provided upon request at registration
- Venue Management reserves the right to refuse participation or entry
- Employees of the venue are unable to participate, however friends and family are approved

4. Entry Fee

- Entry is \$50 per participant
- Entry must be paid in full by CASH only at registration
- Entries close prior to kick off of Round 1 Sunday March 1st
- Entry fees are strictly non-refundable once round 1 has commenced

5. Registration

Participants must complete a Registration form signed by duty management with the following details:

- Name
- Contact number
- Email
- Confirmation of Payment
- Proof of age

6. How to Participate

- Participants must submit tips for each round prior to the first scheduled match of that round. These can be made on site, via email or over the phone to Management.
- Late submissions will not be accepted, and participants will receive zero points for that round
- No changes to tips can be made once the round has commenced

7. Scoring

- 1 point is awarded for each correct tip
- A nominated "Game of the round" margin must be selected weekly by the venue
- Margin selections are used as a tie breaker for weekly and season placings
- If a match is declared a draw, no points are awarded

8. Weekly Prizes

The participant with the highest correct tips for that round is declared the round winner. In the event of a tied:

1. Closest margin to the nominated game of the round wins

2. If still tied, lowest cumulative margin difference wins

- Weekly winners receive a randomly drawn prize from an approved weekly prize pool: vouchers, merch, tickets
- Winners must be present at the venue to claim prize, if not present a redraw will occur

9. Perfect round bonus

- Any participant who correctly tips all matches in a round will receive a \$100 venue voucher.
- Multiple round winners may be awarded if achieved by more than one participant

10. Major Prizes

- 1st place - \$1000 cash prize, XXXX Gold Premium Merch Pack and \$150 venue voucher
- 2nd place - \$250 cash prize, XXXX Gold Standard Merch Pack & \$100 venue voucher
- 3rd place - \$100 cash prize, XXXX Gold Slab, \$50 Venue Voucher

Season placings are determined by total correct tips across all regular season rounds.

If tied at season end:

- Total correct margin results across the season
- Lowest cumulative margin difference
- If still tied, a coin toss on venue premises will determine winner

Major prize winners do not need to be present to redeem their placing winnings and will be contacted via the details provided upon registration.

11. Forfeiture & Disqualification

The venue reserves the right to:

- Disqualify any participant suspected of cheating or altering tipping sheets
- Disqualify participants engaging in misconduct within the venue premises
- Refuse participation to banned or excluded patrons

All decisions by Venue Management are final.

13. Prize Conditions

- Venue vouchers must be redeemed within validity period
- Vouchers are not redeemable for cash
- Alcohol prizes will only be issued in accordance with RSA
- The venue reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal value if required

14. Liability

Acacia Ridge Hotel is not responsible for:

- Lost, illegal or misplaced tipping sheets
- Incorrect contact details provided by participants
- Any technical errors affecting match outcomes

15. Privacy

Personal information collected is used solely for administration of the competition and will not be sold or shared with third parties except where required by law.
